

### Skeuomorphic Era (2015-2016)

Very fragmented and more flexible discussion that centered around possibilities.

Ethereum Subreddit] was
the main place where
people held
conversations and it was
the source of truth.
Classic tech trajectory:
skeuomorphic first, then
experimentation into new
things.

### Code Is Law Era (2016-2017)

Moved from new to weird. Narrative and experiments were very practical.

How do we certify bylaws and vote using bylaws? How do we make onchain shareholder organizations?

Code is Law was a reaction to the Bitcoin community about what DAOs could be.

"A DAO should be a relatively strict organization."

World Computer was the driving meme. People weren't talking about DAOs as organizations.

"DAOs as Code."

Heat of the Code is Law debate with The DAO as this era's posterchild.



- Move away from Coin Voting: Optimism
- Novel Incentive Mechanisms: <u>Nouns DAO</u>, <u>JokeDAO</u>
  <u>Delegation Models Rising</u>
- DAOS and the Law: functional or even regulatory equivalence
- US Regulation Lawsuit against <u>bZx DAO</u>, <u>Ooki DAO</u>
- Non-US, DAO-friendly regulation: <u>DAOSquare</u>, <u>Yamakoshi Village DAO</u>, <u>da0</u>

## 4. What DAOs Need

J It's not about decentralization or autonomy but rather building collectives that reliably and legitimately produce valuable goods and services

- 1. Intuitive and easy interfaces, experiences, and structures
- 2. Modular primitives that are built "aware" of each other
- 3. Best practices from remote, flat, OSS orgs
- 4. Supercharging existing, not just novel use cases
- 5. Primitives and interfaces emphasizing the unique benefits of DAOs
- Crypto-native assets that are valuable but not necessarily priced
- 7. Delivering legitimate, compliant, and reliable produces and services
